- **PLEASE PRAY:** The Church of the Brethren (COB) in Nigeria is experiencing increasing suffering brought on by an attempt by Boko Haram insurgents to make northeast Nigeria into an Islamic rule. Estimates are that more than 90,000 Church of the Brethren members in Nigeria have been displaced by the fighting this year. They have seen many of the COB churches and congregations destroyed, as thousands of church members have been killed and pastors and their families have been among the hundreds more people abducted since the Chibok schoolgirls were taken.
