"From the fig tree learn its lesson: as soon as it branch becomes tender and puts out leaves, you know that summer is near. So also when you see these things taking place, you know that he is near, at the very gates. Truly, I say to you this generation will not pass away until all these things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

- Some see, in the immediate context, the destruction by Rome as partial fulfilment
- "This generation" most naturally refers to the present generation of people alive, not the whole human race, all Jews, or the church.
