## Introduction:

## Obedience... (V12)

### In the face of uncertainty and fear

*“Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet...”* (v12) (see 1:4)

Earlier, Jesus had challenged them about a disconnect between what they confess with their mouths and what they live out in daily actions.

*“Why do you call me ‘Lord, Lord’ and not do what I tell you? - Luke 6:46*  
(see also 1 Samuel 15:22)

## Prayer... (V14)

### As an active part of the waiting

*“All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus and his brothers”* (v14)

Jesus modeled prayer as an important part of walking with God. As we move forward in Acts, we will see that the power and presence of God often follows the prayers of His people. (Romans 12:12, Colossians 4:2)

*One accord* and *devotion* = the group was united in their commitment to prayer
