### Introduction:

### God Sends His Spirit... (V1-4)

#### The Day of Pentecost

*“When the day of Pentecost came, they were all gathered together in one place...” (v1)*

Pentecost was a harvest festival that marks 50 days from Passover.

**They were gathered together in one place....**

#### The Spirit comes suddenly....

*“Suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting...” (v2)*

*“Divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them...” (v3)*

**Persistent, corporate prayer was the environment into which God sent His Spirit.**

*“And they were all filled with the Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance...” (v4)*

## **The Spirit Draws (V5-8)**

### **“At this sound”...**

## **Demonstrating God's Heart... (V9-12)**

### **For “every nation under heaven”...**

The list in verses 8-11 covers regions around the Mediterranean Sea and included all known nations at that time.

What they heard in their own languages was the “mighty works of God” (v11)

This is fulfilling Isaiah 42:6 (and other passages) about Jesus being a light to the nations. In Him, we take His light to all peoples, by the Spirit.

## **Mixed Responses (v12)**

*“And all were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another ‘What does this mean?’ But others, mocking, said ‘They are filled with new wine’.” (V12)*
